

## **East Iowa Bible Camp Participation and Release Agreement**

Thank you for joining us here at EIBC for some fun! We are excited to have you here and look forward to providing you with an opportunity to grow spiritually while enjoying a variety of programs and activities.

Because many of these activities are outdoors and involve physical activity, our attorneys say we need to let you know accidents can happen. While we are excited for you to experience things like competitive field sports, volleyball, tire swinging, basketball, hiking, water trampolining, swimming, giant swinging and zip lining, and we do our best to ensure everyone's safety, we cannot eliminate all risk. We all know bumps, bruises and scrapes are part of a camp experience, but in rare situations activities like these can cause serious injury or death. We do not say this to scare you, but we want you to be fully aware that these risks, however slight, do exist.

Parents/Guardians – by choosing to allow your child to participate, you acknowledge that you understand the above risks, accept them, and willingly give your child permission to participate. You also represent that your child has no physical or emotional conditions that would prevent them from safely participating in EIBC activities, you have explained these risks to them in a way they understand, and you have directed them to follow all safety rules and all instructions given by EIBC staff, employees and counselors.

Campers – by choosing to participate in activities at EIBC, you acknowledge that you understand the above risks, that you have talked with your parent(s)/guardian(s) about them and you are willing to participate by your own choice. **You also agree that you will obey all safety rules and all instructions given by EIBC staff, employees and counselors. If you do not feel comfortable participating in an activity, for any reason, you agree to let us know.** While we want you to experience new things here at EIBC, we want you to feel safe so your stay is memorable and enjoyable.

Parents/Guardians/Campers – In exchange for the opportunity to stay at EIBC and participate in activities, you agree that you assume all risk of the activities, you will not sue EIBC, its counselors, staff, employees, directors and officers (“Released Parties”), and you fully release and hold harmless the Released Parties from all liability, expenses, costs and damages (including property damage) arising from, or

related to, your stay at EIBC and participation in the activities. You further waive any other right you, or a third-party, may have to make any type of claim against the Released Parties related to your stay at EIBC and your participation in activities.

You give EIBC personnel permission to provide basic first aid treatment. In the event of an emergency, you give permission for EIBC to summon emergency medical services to treat, stabilize and transport the camper to an appropriate medical facility. EIBC will use the contact information you provide to notify you of the situation. EIBC does not provide health insurance. You agree you are responsible for all costs associated with any medical care you may require.

Photographs, video and/or sound recordings of your child may be made during their time at EIBC. You consent to EIBC's use of these recordings for marketing, advertising and social media purposes.

We trust this time at EIBC will be safe and enjoyable. By signing below, you consent to, and agree to be bound by, the terms of this Release and Participation Agreement.
